The Decision Process

Students are considered based on **all** material that they hand in for the application process as well as the CAT examination they sit for in January. Applicants will receive a letter in the mail from Colonel By informing them of their application status.

If a student is not chosen in the first round they will be placed on a wait list. The wait list is divided into quarters, thus someone in the First Quarter is in a better position to be accepted than someone in the Second, Third, or Fourth Quarter. Notification of which quarter a student is in is sent through the mail to the applicant's home address.

We anticipate that we will be able to send letters out by the beginning of March.

Upon being accepted for admission, the school will issue a Memorandum of Understanding to be signed by both the applicant and parent(s)/guardian(s) that is to be returned to the school along with next year's annual fee of \$300.

Should a student accept and at a later date decide to decline the offer of admission, a \$150 refund of the annual fee will be issued up until March 9th.

The personal information on this application and all related application documentation is collected under the authority of the Education Act and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. The information will only be used for the purpose of considering applications to the International Bacclaireate Program. Original applications and reference submissions will not be returned to or shared with applicants or others.
